India accounts for 80% of Asia's and 20% of global production

India's average yield of millets at 1239 kg/ ha is higher than the global average

The Government of Karnataka has been a leader in promotion of millets - The first Organics and Millets Fair was held in 2017, the second and third editions in 2018 and 2019 in Bengaluru. The year 2018 was declared as the National Year of Millets by the Government of India.

The United Nation General Assembly (UNGA) declared 2023 as International Year of Millets (IYOM), ratifying the proposal by India that was supported by 75 countries.
